**NOTIFICATION**

**No.SOR-III(S&GAD)1-10/2008(P-I).** In exercise of the powers conferred under section 23 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 (VIII of 1974), Governor of the Punjab is pleased to direct that in the Punjab Anti-Corruption Establishment Service Rules, 2007 the following amendments shall be made:

**AMENDMENTS**

In the Punjab Anti-Corruption Establishment Service Rules, 2007, in the Schedule:

- (1) at Sr. No. 22 (Inspector):
  - (a) In column No.7, for the existing entries, the following shall be substituted:
    - (I) 50% by posting of suitable officers from the Police department having Bachelor's degree (2<sup>nd</sup> division) from a University recognized by Higher Education Commission;
    - (II) 20% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Sub-Inspectors of ACE having 5 years' regular service as such and who have successfully completed four months mandatory Upper Class Course from Police College; and
    - (III) 30% by initial recruitment through Punjab Public Service Commission. If none is available for promotion or initial recruitment, by posting of a suitable officer from the Police department."
  - (b) In column No. 10, for the existing entry, the following shall be substituted:

"Six-month pre-service training from Police College for those who are appointed by initial recruitment."
- (2) at Sr. No. 28 (Sub-Inspector), in column No.7, for the existing entries, the following shall be substituted:
  - (I) 40% by posting of suitable Sub-Inspectors from the Police department;
  - (II) 60% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Assistant Sub-Inspectors of ACE having 5 years' regular service as such.

If none is available for promotion, by posting of a suitable officer from the Police department."; and
- (3) at Sr. no. 33 (Assistant Sub-Inspector), in column No. 7, for the existing entries, the following shall be substituted:

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- (I) 40% by posting of Assistant Sub-Inspectors from the Police department;
- (II) 30% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Head Constables of ACE having seven years' regular service as such; and
- (III) 30% by initial recruitment through Punjab Public Service Commission.

If none is available for promotion, by posting of Assistant Sub-Inspectors from the Police department."


