In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 23 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974, and in pursuance of the Provisions of Rule 3 of the Punjab Civil Servants (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1974, the Governor of the Punjab is pleased to make the following rules, namely:-

THE PUNJAB COMMUNICATION AND WORKS DEPARTMENT
(ENGINEERING POSTS QUALIFICATIONS & CONDITIONS
FOR RECRUITMENT) RULES, 1985.

1. These Rules may be called the Punjab Communication & Works Department (Engineering Posts qualifications & Conditions for Recruitment) Rules, 1985.
2. They shall come into force at once.
3. The method of recruitment, minimum qualifications, age limit and other matters related thereto for the posts shall be as given in the schedule annexed.
4. The following rules are hereby repealed:-
 - i) The West Pakistan Service of Civil Engineers (Buildings & Roads) (Class-I) Rules, 1967.
 - ii) The West Pakistan Service of Civil Engineers (Buildings & Roads) (Class-II) Rules, 1967.
 - iii) The Punjab Public Works Department, Buildings & Roads Branch, Subordinate Engineering Service (Recruitment & Conditions of Service) Rules, 1943.
 - iv) The West Pakistan Buildings Department Subordinate Engineering Service (Electrical & Mechanical) Rules, 1969.
