No.SOR-III(S&GAD)1-9/2008(P) In exercise of the powers conferred under section 23 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 (VIII of 1974), the Governor of the Punjab is pleased to make the following rules:

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be cited as the Punjab Fisheries Department Service Rules, 2011.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Method of recruitment etc.— The method of recruitment, minimum qualifications, age limits and other incidental matters for the posts of Fisheries Department shall be such as given in the Schedule appended to these rules.
- Repeal:- The following rules are hereby repealed:
 - The Punjab Fisheries Department Service Rules, 1976.
 - (2) The West Pakistan Fisheries Department Ministerial Service (Headquarter) Rules, 1962.
 - (3) The Punjab Fisheries Department Ministerial Service (Regional) Rules, 1988.

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
