NOTIFICATION

No.SOR-III(S&GAD)1-7/2004(PI). In exercise of the powers conferred under section 23 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 (VIII of 1974), Governor of the Punjab is pleased to direct that in the Punjab Irrigation Department (Engineering Posts) Service Rules 2013, the following further amendments shall be made:

AMENDMENTS

In the Punjab Irrigation Department (Engineering Posts) Service Rules 2013, in the Schedule, at Sr. No. 4, in column 7, for the existing entries, the following shall be substituted:

- (i) 60% by initial recruitment;
- (ii) 05% by selection through the Punjab Public Service Commission from amongst the Sub-Engineers (BS-11) with three years' service in the functional unit and are B.E or B.Sc. Civil Engineering or Mechanical Engineering from a university recognized by the Pakistan Engineering Council and are registered therewith.
If none is available, then by initial recruitment.
- (iii) 14% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Sub-Engineers (BS-11) who are:
 - (a) B.E or B.Sc. Civil Engineering or Mechanical Engineering, as the case may be or Associate Member Institution of Engineer in relevant discipline from a university recognized by the Pakistan Engineering Council with three years' regular service in the functional unit; or
 - (b) B. Tech (Honors) from an institute or a university recognized by the Higher Education Commission with five years' regular service in the functional unit and who have:
 - (i) obtained study leave from the competent authority for acquiring higher degrees;
 - (ii) attended the course in the campus located with territorial jurisdiction of the University recognized by the Higher Education Commission; and
 - (iii) possessed relevant degrees along with transcripts and role of attendance issued by the University.
- (iv) 1% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Sub-Engineers (BS-11) with three years' regular service in the functional unit and who are M.Sc. Civil Engineering or Mechanical Engineering from a university recognized by the Pakistan Engineering Council and registered with it.
If none is available, then by initial recruitment.
- (v) 20% by promotion on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Senior Sub Engineers (BS-16) with ten years' regular service in the functional unit and who have passed the prescribed Departmental Professional Examination."


