No. No. SOR-III(S&GAD)1-37/2006. In exercise of the powers conferred under section 23 of the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 (VIII of 1974), Governor of the Punjab is pleased to make the following rules:

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be cited as the Punjab Transport Department (Transport Authority/ Technical Wing) Service Rules 2015.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. Method of recruitment.— The method of recruitment, minimum qualification, age limit and other incidental matters for the posts of the functional unit shall be such as given in the Schedule appended to these rules.

3. Repeal.— The Punjab Transport Department (Technical Wing Posts) Service Rules, 2011 and the Punjab Transport Department (Transport Authorities) Service Rules, 2012 are hereby repealed.
